We are non-denominational and ecumenical. It does not matter where you live, what religion you are or are not, how long you have been out of work, or what kind of work you need. All are welcome. Since 1995, we have helped more than 4,000 people to recover from their job loss.

OUR GOAL

Our goal is to help you find a family supporting position and benefits and to provide you with friendship, understanding and a support network while you go through this difficult transition.

CHAPTERS

We now have Chapters in five suburban Phila. Counties. Chapters, meetings and events are open to all members. You can belong to one Chapter and visit others and go to any event.

COST

There is never a charge for anything Joseph's People provides or events we hold. Everything we do for you is FREE.

WHAT WE DO

While you are in transition to a new job, you may run into hurdles that make life difficult. At Joseph's People, we have developed resources and access to resources to help you.

As a person who has worked all your life, you frequently do not qualify for many programs. Our Blue Resource Guide is the combined wisdom of thousands of our graduates who have found places to get help. It covers all manner of problems...financial, medical, food, clothing, etc. etc.
